

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Choose between student hall of residence or private accommodation, e.g. shared accommodation (Wohngemeinschaft, short: WG)
- Broadcasting licence fees
- The brochure on the right
 is available both in <u>English</u> and <u>German</u>
- If you wish to rent a room in a hall of residence, but are NOT coming to Giessen on an exchange program, you must submit your application directly to <u>Studierendenwerk</u>



IMPORTANT WORDS YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Zwischenmiete: sublease (rent in someone's room or an appartment for a short period of time)
- Nebenkosten (NK): additional costs (additional costs which typically include water, heating, electricity, building insurance and any other costs.)
- Kaltmiete (KM): basic rent (rent without additional costs)
- Warmmiete (WM): rent which typically includes heating and water costs,
 usually excludes electricity costs and/or internet
- Erdgeschoss (EG): ground floor
- Communal living vs "Zweck-WG"

Abbrevations in adverts for accommodation and rooms

2 MM KT	Two months' deposit
Abstand / Ablöse (Key money / one-off payment)	The previous tenant may request an apartment transfer fee for the fur- niture, eg. for the kitchen, a bed or other pieces of furniture. This means that the person wishes for you to purchase some of the furniture in the room/apartment. It may also be a small fee for a new washing machi- ne or kitchen fittings. The apartment transfer fee is a contract of sale. There is no legal obligation to assume the costs.

SHARED ACCOMMODATION

- In German "Wohngemeinschaft", short: WG
- Very common form of accommodation for students in Germany
 - Each person has their own room, bathroom and kitchen are shared
 - Furnished or unfurnished
- Proof of income / guarantor
 - Frequently required if you want to rent an entire apartment
 - If you rent a room in a shared apartment, that is not usually the case

SHARED ACCOMMODATION

- Once you have found a WG whose description fits your requirements, you will need to contact them (by phone, WhatsApp or email)
- An example message is shown on the next slide and in the brochure <u>Finding</u>
 <u>Accommodation</u> on p. 15
- Wait for an appointment, the "WG casting", as it will be arranged for you to view the accommodation and meet your future flatmates if the WG thinks you are suitable

EXAMPLE MESSAGE


