#### WHAT IS MEET2SUCCEED?

meet2succeed is an extra-curricular and free programme for international students in English-taught masters. The aim of the programme is to facilitate students the start of their studies at JLU. Within the programme students take part in three building blocks: tutorials, language courses and status talks.

If you are a student in your first or second semester in one of the English-taught masters at faculty 05 or faculty 09, feel free to join the programme!



# 1. TUTORIALS

In tutorials, experienced students from higher semesters support international first and second semester students in subject-related and JLU-related matters. Students can choose from a range of subject-specific tutorials to tutorials about technical applications:

- getting to know JLU, e.g. the electronic systems, module planning or library use
- learning to give a presentation
- learning to write a term paper
- deepening subject-specific content



#### 2. LANGUAGE COURSES

German language skills are essential for integration into every-day life in Germany and for gaining a foothold in the German job market during or after graduation. Therefore, meet2succeed offers German language courses from an intermediate level with a focus on technical language. Additionally, English courses are offered at faculty 09 because an academic knowledge of English is also a necessary basis for successful studies. The language courses are specially tailored to suit your field of study.

# 3. STATUS TALKS

As a third component, meet2succeed offers status talks in the form of a personal, confidential consultation in which students can talk openly about their individual situation. Possible topics of discussion include finding one's way around the German higher education system, academic challenges, aspects of immigration law and social integration.
